ILLNESS

We have noticed an increase in winter illnesses, including coughs, colds, and flu-like symptoms, circulating within our school community.

To help protect our tamariki, staff, and wider community, please remember that **home is the best place to recover** if your child is unwell.

When to keep your child home:

- They are too sick to learn or participate normally.
- They have a fever, severe cough, or sore throat.
- They have vomited or had diarrhoea (please keep them home for **48 hours** after their last symptom).

If your child has a mild runny nose or a slight, non-persistent cough but is otherwise happy, energetic, and well enough to learn, they are welcome to attend.
