The Prime Minister has announced this evening that Alert Level 3 restrictions will begin from 6.00am tomorrow morning, for the Auckland region. The period of time indicated is 7 days.

3. Online learning - teachers will work together on Monday to prepare the online learning for Week 5. This learning will be sent out to all learners at 9.00am on Tuesday 2nd March. Tomorrow, you will receive some great challenges and fun tasks to do on Monday - keep an eye on your emails at 3.00pm.
4. Device management - we understand that some whanau will need devices in order for their learner(s) to have access to this week's learning. Please contact Kimberley Rivett via email krivett@alfriston.school.nz if you require a loaned school Chromebook for your child's learning.
