Cash/eftpos/credit card payments available <u>Please note</u>: All students must be accompanied to the book fair by their parents or caregiver.

## How the Book Fair works...

• Students will visit the Book Fair with their teacher and create their *'wish list'* to bring home to parents/caregivers. Also remember to look at the book fair catalogue. Orders can be made by returning the back page order form with payment <u>by credit card only</u>.

#### Parents/caregivers then have the option to do the following

- Visit the Book Fair with your child between <u>2.45-3.15pm on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday</u> to browse/buy books (cash and eftpos available)
- Complete the catalogue payment order form (credit card option) and send along with your child on <u>Monday</u>.
- On <u>Wednesday</u> send the correct <u>money</u> along in an envelope/snaplock bag with your child's name on it and the items for purchase. Your child will be accompanied to the PAC to pay and receive their book choices.
- Should the book be out of stock, orders will be taken and books will be delivered to classrooms once they arrive at school.
- Invite grandparents to come along for the <u>Thursday</u> Book Character Parade, stay for morning tea and visit the book fair to purchase a book (optional).
- Grandparents are able to purchase for children or they might like to make a purchase as a donation to our school library. Any donated books will have a *'donated by'* label attached to the book for all readers to see.
- During the course of the week lunchtime activities will be held for students in the Learning Resource Centre (behind the library).
