CDIOT/

- The pool attendant on duty will admit entry to passholders who can provide photographic ID to match their pass. Passes are not transferable and include up to 4 adults (Grandparents may bring grandchildren) a total of 5 children per pass. The pass is not intended for you to host a lot of friends
- The pool is available for the enjoyment of all passholders. Please respect and consider the comfort and convenience of others using the pool.
- Only children accompanied by an adult are allowed into the pool area and the adults (+ 18yrs) are responsible for the children they are supervising.
- Abide by all pool rules as published in the pool enclosure and the Pool attendants requests. They are here for your safety representing the Alfriston School Board and enforcing the rules.
- The Alfriston School Board accepts no responsibility for damage or loss to personal property.
- Use the toilet and wash your hands before entering the pool. If you have had diarrhea in the last 2 weeks do not swim.
- Respect others in regards to noise. E.G. Keeping music volumes down.
- No ball play or large floating toys when the pool is crowded. Show respect to other swimmers give them space and allow them to swim safely without being hit by a ball etc...
- Absolutely no diving, bombing, dunking or rough play. This will result in person/s removed from the pool.
- Do not stand on the pool rail or walk on the edge of the junior pool.
- Swim only in swimming togs/ rash vest. Toddlers and babies should wear form-fitting togs and purpose designed swimming nappies. No T-shirts, singlets, undergarments are to be used as swimwear.
- No smoking/vaping or alcohol in the pool area. No glass
- No bikes, skates (or similar) and animals in the pool area.
- Please take all belongings and rubbish with you, including all food scraps / crumbs.

Any malfunction, or misuse of the pool and environs should be notified at once to the pool attendant.

Please note the school reserves the right to:

- Exclude passholders at anytime if it feels the quality of the water is below the standard requirement.
- Recall passes through failure of the passholders to observe the conditions of use or sharing of pass.
- Close the pool due to poor or dangerous weather conditions. The pool will close during thunderstorms.
- Close the pool for extenuating circumstances. For example pool cleaning, equipment breakage/malfunction, covid.

The Pool Attendant has the right to deny access or request Passholders to leave if rules have been breached.
