## **2026 STUDENT LEADERSHIP**

Alfriston School's third Strategic Goal is 'Ongoing Internal Evaluation' which ensures we are constantly reviewing and reflecting in order to improve.

For the past few years we have been looking for ways to strengthen our Student Leadership Programme. We want to ensure that when learners are designated a role there are enough opportunities for them to fulfil the role. We also want to make sure that their leadership is being developed - that we are intentionally supporting the learners to develop skills like decision making, problem solving, communication etc.

In order to do this there will be some changes in 2026. We will not have Head and Deputy students, instead we will have a 'Student Leadership Team'. This will be a team of 8 learners whom we have identified as being role models. Learners who have been fully involved in many aspects of school life and whom we identify as leading in some way already.
