HOLIDAY HAMPER RAFFLE!

The Family and Friends of Alfriston School group are excited to announce that our Holiday Hamper Raffle is back for **yet another year!** This Holiday Hamper Raffle is to fundraise for our amazing school and twenty lucky winners will get to enjoy a hamper of holiday treats.

We have three payment options available again this year. These options are **Cash, Eftpos and KINDO**. Here is how it will work.

CASH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tick the cash option box on the ticket and fill in the details • Send the money to school with the raffle sheet and give it to your classroom teacher. Someone will come around to collect them from your teacher each morning. • If you are able to cut the tickets up before handing them to the office that would be amazing, otherwise the office will do this before the final draw.
EFTPOS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tick the Eftpos option box on the ticket and fill in the details • Bring in your raffle sheet with all the details filled in and pay by Eftpos at the Office • If you are able to cut the tickets up before handing them to the office that would be amazing, otherwise the office will do this before the final draw.
KINDO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tickets are ordered and paid for on KINDO • Once these have been ordered on KINDO, the office will send the raffle sheet/s in an envelope to your child's classroom. Please fill in the details on the raffle sheet and give them back to your classroom teacher. Someone will come around and collect them from your teacher each morning. • If you are able to cut the tickets up before handing them to the office that would be amazing, otherwise the office will do this before the final draw.

Important things to know.....

- Each raffle sheet has 10 tickets on it
- Tickets are \$2 each- whole sheet is \$20
- Extra raffles sheets are available from the office
- You can choose any payment option that suits you
- You have just over four weeks to sell as many tickets as possible.

Top Selling Class Award

The class that achieves the highest sales will be rewarded with a movie in the PAC and an iceblock.

All tickets and money will need to be returned by **Tuesday 24th March**, and hampers and prize draw will be drawn on **Friday 27th March at the final Whanau Assembly for Term 1**. Winners will be contacted if they aren't in attendance at the Assembly and the hampers will then be available to collect from the office by **Wednesday 1st April**

We will also be holding a mufti day on **Thursday 19th March**. On this day, students are encouraged to bring along an item as specified below, *if they choose to wear mufti*. These items will be used to make up hampers for the raffle.

Please make sure ALL items are NEW - not expired or in damaged packaging.

No “fresh” items or opened packages, please.

Mufti Day Items:

You do not have to go and buy every item on your child’s list. If you would like to donate more than one item then it would be very much appreciated.

Year 0,1	Snack foods - Boxes of muesli bars, nuts, dried fruit, chips, popcorn or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 2	Packets of mousse, jelly, meal makers (Maggi cook in the pot/ veggie bake) or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 3	Cereal, dried pasta, uncooked rice, etc. or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 4	A tin of fruit, vegetables, baked beans, spaghetti, or meal condiment (i.e. pasta sauce, just add...). or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 5	Box or packet of crackers, biscuits, slice or loaf (must be in sealed packets not freshly baked) Or Toiletries such as shampoo, bodywash, soap, tissues and toothpaste. or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 6	Jar of pickles, olives, cocktail onions, sun-dried tomatoes or chutneys/pickles, or spreads (Jam, Marmite/Vegemite, peanut butter etc.) Or Toiletries such as shampoo, bodywash, soap, tissues and toothpaste. or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 7	Something sweet, like chocolates, biscuits, or lollies/Easter Eggs etc Or Toiletries such as shampoo, bodywash, soap, tissues and toothpaste. or Easter Eggs of any kind
Year 8	A bottle of something to drink. This can be a soft drink, cordial or juice (not fresh). No alcoholic beverages please. Toiletries such as shampoo, bodywash, soap, tissues and toothpaste. or Easter Eggs of any kind

If any parents or whānau are able to donate items from their workplaces or have contacts who may be willing to donate products or vouchers, we would be incredibly grateful. All donations big or small help us to “bulk up” our hampers and make them even more exciting for our community.

- All tickets and money are due back to school on ***Tuesday 24th March***
- ***Mufti day - Thursday 19th March***. Bring in a raffle item- see above for details
- Raffles to be drawn and winners notified on ***Friday 27th March at the final Whanau Assembly*** with hampers to be picked up by **Wednesday 1st April**.
